

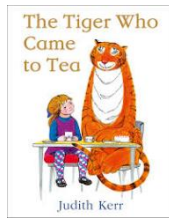


## Communication, Language and Literacy

### targets:

Please encourage your child to;

- \* Trace over or copy their name.
- \* Make marks on paper using pens and pencils and to tell you what they have written.
- \* Share their reading book and begin to identify the words and pictures.
- \* Play I Spy to begin to recognise the beginning sounds in familiar words.
- \* To make up stories using familiar characters and objects.
