Please encourage your child to;

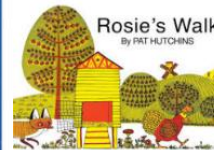
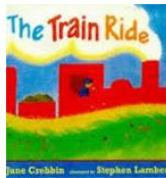
- * Trace over or copy their name.
- * Make marks on paper using pens and pencils and to tell you what they have written.
- * Share their reading book and begin to run their finger under the words.
- * Play I Spy to begin to recognise the beginning sounds in familiar words.

- * To begin to tell short stories using their toys.
- * Start to talk about similarities and differences. For example how the windows in a car are a similar shape to windows on a house, how all vehicles have similar wheels. etc.* To describe a journey they have been on and talk about going on longer journeys.
- * To be aware of the basic road safety rules and be able to walk nicely and hold an adults hand.

Maths targets:

Please encourage your child to:

- * Join in with counting to 10 and beyond and count sets of objects.
- * Begin to use the words more and fewer when comparing two sets of objects.
- * Sort and describe their sorting, e.g group objects by colour.
- * Describe shapes using the correct language – pointy corners, straight sides, slopey sides and curved.
- * Show awareness of subitizing to five – recognising how many objects are in a set without counting them.
- * Make sets in different ways, for example, encourage your child to hold up 4 fingers then show you in a different way.
